Paid Embalming Services GIMS, Greater Noida (UP)

Embalming is the art and science of preserving human body by treating them (in its modern form with chemicals) to forestall decomposition. Department of Anatomy, GIMS, Greater Noida wants to extend this facility to the common people who want to keep the dead body of their relative for quite some more time for viewing purpose or for transportation to distant place for final rites.



Purpose of Embalming:

We strive to assist common people by providing embalming facility on requests:

- 1. To keep the body preserved till the arrival of the close relatives of the deceased.
- 2. To transport the body to the home town of the deceased in India or abroad.
- **3.** On request by other medical College/Hospital where Embalming facility is not available.
- **4.** On request by Government Agencies like: Airport, District Administration & Military Services for embalming dead bodies.

Process for Embalming:

1. To avail this facility, the legal heir of the deceased can fill the application form and submit the form addressing to the Director, GIMS, and Greater Noida within 4-6 hours of death.

2. Documents Required:

- Duly filled Application form
- Receipt of charges deposited for Paid Embalming
- Aadhaar Card of Deseased person
- Aadhaar Card of Applicant
- Death Certificate
- Certificate stating that the diseased did not have any communicable disease.
- A coffin maker's certificate is necessary for transport.

3. Charges for Embalming and Body Retaining:

- Embalming Charges: Rs. 5,000/-
- **Body Retaining Charges:** Rs. 1,000/- per day if the body has to be kept in the anatomy department due to delay in transportation.

Note:

- Hearse Van and Coffin (Transporting agencies accept embalmed bodies packed in a coffin) has to be arranged by the applicant.
- An embalming certificate will be issued by the department of Anatomy after completion of the procedure.
