1. It is certified that the Government Institute of Medical Sciences, Greater Noida has permitted U/s 11 (2) of the IMC Act. 1956 for 100 seats in MBBS course.
2. No. of Institutions already existing in the state : 15
3. No. of Institutions offering MBBS : 15
4. No. of seats available in the MBBS course in the State : 1670 (state quota)
