Government Institute of Medical Sciences (GIMS), Greater Noida, Gautam Buddha Nagar, was established on 15 February 2016 by the Government of Uttar Pradesh as an autonomous, not-for-profit academic medical centre, modelled on SGPGIMS, registered under the Societies Registration Act and affiliated to Atal Bihari Vajpayee Medical University, Lucknow. Guided by the vision to be a Centre of Excellence in patient care, medical education, biomedical research and disease prevention, GIMS serves the communities of western Uttar Pradesh and neighbouring states with equitable, high-quality care.

The Institute launched its MBBS programme in 2019 and has since expanded postgraduate training with DNB (from 2020) and MD/MS (from 2024) across multiple specialties. Allied health sciences have grown through a College of Nursing (Mentor College under Mission Niramaya) and an Institute of Paramedical Sciences, while GIMS Vidya SETU delivers hands-on skill training in ICU/ventilator management, BCLS/ACLS and NSDC-HSSC/IGNOU modules. Clinical services are delivered through 630-bedded, NABH-accredited teaching hospital with NABL-accredited laboratories. The hospital manages around 1,500 OPD visits daily with over 450 modular supported by OTs, advanced critical CT/MRI/mammography/fluoroscopy facilities, dialysis services and a dedicated Type-1 Diabetes Centre of Excellence, with e-Sanjeevani tele-consultations extending our reach.

Research and innovation are anchored by the Department of Medical Research (2020). The Molecular Diagnostics & Research Laboratory (2020) holds ICMR and ICMR-NIV accreditations with WHO-qualified workflows. The Multi-Disciplinary Research Unit (sanctioned 11 October 2021) houses a comprehensive instrument suite for molecular and applied research. The Viral Research & Diagnostics Laboratory (sanctioned 4 October 2021) ranks among top-performing national VRDLs of the nation. The Genome Sequencing Facility (inaugurated 19 June 2022) is INSACOG-recognised. Across units, more than 200 investigator-initiated projects flourish with extramural support from ICMR, CSIR, DBT, WHO and MoHFW.

GIMS now hosts a public hospital-based Medical Incubation Centre and the GIMS Startup Clinic—the first clinic for startups in a public hospital. The platform offers clinical mentoring, idea validation, pathways for efficacy and clinical trials, an IPR clinic, funding linkages and national networking, and is building a Diseases Prevention Cohort to catalyse affordable, accessible innovations. In parallel, GIMS has been empanelled as an IGNOU Learner Support Centre (Regular) for the School of Health Sciences, offering two programmes for MBBS graduates with January

admission: the Post-Graduate Diploma in Maternal and Child Health (PGDMCH) and the Post-Graduate Diploma in Geriatric Medicine (PGDGM)

A near-full-strength, residential faculty sustains high academic standards; our students have secured top national ranks, including in INI-CET. GIMS was recognised as the Best Medical College in COVID-19 Care Management in Uttar Pradesh. A green, student-centric campus with modern hostels, vibrant clubs and strong mentorship fosters holistic growth with zero tolerance for ragging. Looking ahead, we are deepening our research-innovation pipeline, expanding skill development and paramedical programmes, and accelerating incubation to deliver compassionate, affordable care with measurable impact..



OPD WORKLOAD 2018-2025



IN-PATIENT WORKLOAD 2018-2025



Operations Workload Year 2019-2024




